



# Challenge Call for Innovative Technologies in the Domain of Seawater Desalination

The Environment and Water Industry Development Council (EWI), under the Ministry of the Environment and Water Resources (MEWR), Singapore, is now calling for PRELIMINARY research proposals with breakthrough / disruptive technologies to meet the following challenges:

- ⇒ **Production of drinking water that meets World Health Organisation (WHO) Drinking Water Guidelines;**
- ⇒ **Total energy consumption of 1.5 kWh per cubic metre of water produced, or less.**

Applicants are to submit a 5-page Preliminary Proposal on the proposed technology to meet the above Challenge Call. Applicants of the short-listed Preliminary Proposals will then be invited to submit Full Proposals which will be considered for EWI funding to develop the technology into pilot stage.
